This is our ninth summer packing meals for Haiti, and we are still rejoicing over a major milestone we reached last year — we packed our **two millionth** meal last summer!

Our goal this year is to pack 250,000 meals. This requires \$62,500 in offering to pay for the food that will be packed. We know this can be done — it's a God-sized task, but the students who have attended Youth Weeks the last eight summers have proved we can meet the challenge! We are not only packing food to feed the hungry, we are also providing a way for the gospel of Jesus Christ to be shared with those receiving the meals. Go God!

We are asking that youth groups start **NOW** in helping us reach our goal for 2019. There are so many ways that your church can play a large part in our offering to Jacmel, Haiti. Share with your church that we are now supporting three villages, one hospital, two schools and the House of Abraham with these meals. Plan a prayer meeting to pray for the House of Abraham. Hold a fundraiser. Decorate an offering container with pictures of the children from the House of Abraham. Use your imagination. One church simply put the container in their church and asked for spare change. They were so excited to bring so much more to camp than they had the previous summer! Let the students be creative with their ideas. We are so thankful to the many churches last summer that received special offerings during Vacation Bible School which ultimately played a role in helping us reach our goal in 2018.

These past eight years we have taken a few hours out of one camp afternoon each week to pack meals that are shipped to Haiti, and God has been doing immeasurably more than we could have imagined with these efforts! We get to take part in mission work at Caswell that affects another country! Go God!
